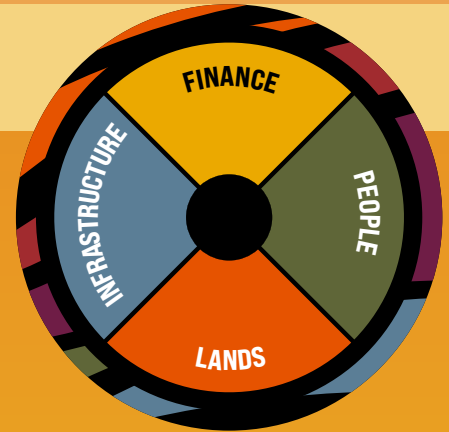


# NATIONAL INDIGENOUS ECONOMIC STRATEGY
